1. Mr. McRobb (Motion #3)

THAT this House urges all members to participate in a non-partisan process of legislative reform with the goal of implementing changes prior to the commencement of the 2007 Spring Sitting of the Yukon Legislative Assembly.

2. Mr. Cardiff (Motion #4)

THAT this House establish, pursuant to Standing Order 45(3.1) and (3.2), a Standing Committee on Appointments to Major Government Boards and Committees consisting of an equal number of members of each of the three caucuses in the Legislative Assembly in addition to a non-voting chair appointed by the Government caucus.

3. Mr. Cardiff (Motion #5)

THAT this House establish, pursuant to Standing Order 45(4), a Select Committee of the Legislative Assembly, consisting of equal representation from all three party caucuses in addition to a non-voting chair, to examine, consider and recommend options for territorial "whistleblower protection" legislation to be introduced no later than the 2008 Fall Sitting; and

That one of the primary duties of this committee shall be to ensure that the needs and wishes of workers are fully considered in the development of such legislation through meaningful consultation with employees and their representatives.
