MOTIONS OTHER THAN GOVERNMENT MOTIONS

1. Mr. Nordick (Motion #61)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to assist elders and seniors in Yukon by:

- (1) increasing the inventory of affordable housing in the territory,
- (2) continuing to ensure that elders and seniors are able to remain in their own homes as long as possible by increasing homecare and other services,
- (3) building elders and seniors housing that enable couples with different medical needs to continue living together as long as possible,
- (4) enabling elders and seniors to live in their own home communities as long as possible,
- (5) completing the construction of the multi-level care facilities in Watson Lake and Dawson City and the seniors facility in Haines Junction, and
- (6) consulting with elders and seniors on the need for senior facilities in Teslin and other communities.

2. Mr. Cardiff (Motion #62)

THAT this House urges the Minister of Health and Social Services and the Minister responsible for the Yukon Housing Corporation to develop a Yukon-specific definition of the term “affordable housing” that is based on what can be afforded by the consumer, rather than on its relation to prevailing market prices, and to take joint action immediately to address the shelter needs of the growing number of Yukon families who are on the Yukon Housing Corporation or Grey Mountain Housing Society waitlists for social housing.

3. Mr. Edzerza (Motion #63)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to immediately increase the food allowance paid to Social Assistance recipients by an amount representing no less than the increase in Yukon’s cost of living since the allowance was last increased in the early 1990s, to index the new rate to the cost of living, and to make the increase retroactive to April 1 of this year.
