1. Mr. Hardy (Motion #134)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to develop and implement a Homeowner Protection Act that includes mandatory licencing for home builders and contractors and an effective warranty program for new home construction and home renovations.

2. Mr. Cardiff (Motion #135)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to take whatever steps are necessary to ensure that all legislation dealing with domestic relationships conforms to the guarantees of equal protection and equal benefits of the law contained in section 15 of the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedom.
