**GOVERNMENT MOTIONS**

1. Hon. Mr. Fentie (Motion #69)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to work collaboratively with the Government of Canada, the Government of the Northwest Territories, the Porcupine Caribou Management Board, all affected First Nations in Yukon and the Northwest Territories, and stakeholders, to develop a Porcupine Caribou Herd Harvest Management Strategy that ensures to the greatest extent possible, the conservation and protection of the Porcupine Caribou Herd.

2. Hon. Mr. Fentie (Motion #167)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon, the Government of Canada and Yukon First Nation governments to develop a timely, inclusive process through the re-instated Intergovernmental Forum to implement the recommendations of the Nine Year Review of the Yukon Final Land Claims Agreements in order to ensure the spirit and intent of the land claims agreements are fulfilled.

3. Hon. Mr. Cathers (Motion #194)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon and the Yukon Registered Nurses Association to continue working together on the development of legislation that will allow Nurse Practitioners to work within their full scope of practice.

4. Hon. Mr. Kenyon (Motion #239)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to continue to work with the Government of Canada, First Nations, Yukon College, members of the business community and non-governmental organizations to:

- (1) enhance and develop labour market initiatives targeting First Nations, older workers, youth, persons with disabilities and immigrants through measures such as

- apprenticeship programs, the Youth Employment Program, the Yukon Nominee Program, the Temporary Foreign Worker Program and other programs,
- (2) develop a national recruiting campaign; and
  - (3) assist in the development of retention incentives for employers.

5. Hon. Mr. Cathers (Motion #357)

THAT this House urges the Department of Health and Social Services to launch a new health promotion initiative to:

- (1) further assist Yukoners who wish to quit smoking by funding a portion of the cost of nicotine replacement therapies; and
- (2) work in partnership with the Motor Vehicles Branch to provide drivers with information on the increased health impacts of smoking within the confined space of a motor vehicle.

6. Hon. Ms. Taylor (Motion #499)

THAT this House urges the Environment critics for the Official Opposition and the Third Party to accept the Yukon Government's invitation to attend the Climate Leaders Summit in Poznan, Poland, as observers, during the dates of December 8-12, 2008.

**MOTIONS OTHER THAN GOVERNMENT MOTIONS**

1. Mr. Nordick (Motion #542)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to request the Employment Standards Board, in conjunction with the Yukon Workers' Compensation, Health and Safety Board, to:

- (1) conduct a thorough review and assessment of the current situation involving the employment of children and young people in the Yukon workforce to ensure their protection from hazardous environments, substances and occupations,
- (2) identify gaps in current employment standards, occupational health and safety, and education legislation in Yukon governing the employment of children and young people, including consultations with parents and employers; and
- (3) present a report on their findings to the Yukon Legislative Assembly within the first 10 days of the next sitting.

2. Mr. Edzerza (Motion #543)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to assist the Whitehorse General Hospital to provide adequate safety of staff and patients on every floor of the hospital, by:

- (1) employing security personnel who are specially trained to deal with mental disorders,
- (2) training all staff to be vigilant about patients who are security risks; and,
- (3) employing trained patient observers for anyone admitted for mental health reasons.

3. Mr. Hardy (Motion #544)

THAT it is the opinion of this House that the decisive election victory of Barack Hussein Obama as the 44th president of the United States on Tuesday, November 4, 2008, was a milestone day in the political and social evolution of that country as well as a great triumph for democracy- and freedom-loving people worldwide.

4. Mr. Hardy (Motion #545)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to collaborate closely with the City of Whitehorse to determine what degree of commitment and support, financial, logistical and otherwise, it needs in order to submit a bid to host the Arctic Winter Games in 2012.
