GOVERNMENT MOTIONS

1. Hon. Mr. Cathers (Motion #25)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to support development of the agriculture sector with actions including:

- (1) working with farmers and industry associations including Yukon Agriculture Association and the Grower's of Organic Food Yukon to implement the Agriculture Multi-Year Development Plan,
- (2) developing a "Yukon-Grown Food Policy" aimed at significantly increasing the production and use of locally-grown vegetables, meat and food products,
- (3) supporting the development of agriculture infrastructure that improves food security, facilitates access to market, and encourages local production of food,
- (4) supporting the development of local markets for Yukon agriculture products through measures including increasing the annual funding for the Fireweed Community Market; and
- (5) working with Yukon farmers to conduct agricultural research.

2. Hon. Mr. Dixon (Motion #119)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to develop and implement a Yukon Water Strategy that will help provide long-term direction for economically and environmentally responsible development, management, and use of water in Yukon and establish principles to guide future decision making.

NOTICE PAPER**MOTIONS OTHER THAN GOVERNMENT MOTIONS**

1. Ms. Hanson (Motion #155)

THAT it is opinion of this House that:

- (1) Government should base its decisions on sound evidence and not ideology; and
- (2) the federal government should reconsider its:
 - (a) decision to eliminate the National Roundtable on the Economy and Environment and the National Council on Welfare; and
 - (b) interference in the operations of Statistics Canada.

2. Ms. McLeod (Motion #156)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to continue to implement the New Community, Heritage, Adventure, Outdoors and Skills 9 (CHAOS) program at the Wood Street Centre to provide integration of the subject area and develop understanding and connections to First Nations knowledge, traditions, skills, values and beliefs.

3. Ms. McLeod (Motion #157)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to use the 2012/13 Budget to commit \$5 million over five years for the Yukon Research Centre and the Yukon Cold Climate Innovation Centre.

4. Ms. McLeod (Motion #158)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to use the 2012/13 Budget to provide \$4.5 million for Kaushee's Place second stage housing in Whitehorse.

5. Mr. Hassard (Motion #159)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to use the 2012/13 Budget to continue making major investments in Yukon's transportation infrastructure including:

- (1) \$500,000 for rehabilitation and surfacing of the Silver Trail,
- (2) \$900,000 for surfacing, spot repairs, and erosion control for the Dempster Highway,
- (3) \$500,000 for the Resource Access Road Program,
- (4) \$1 million for surfacing and safety improvement on various secondary roads throughout the territory; and
- (5) \$1.875 million for improvement projects for the Erik Nielsen Whitehorse International Airport including taxiway improvements, rehabilitation and the installation of a second bridge or jet way.

6. Mr. Tredger (Motion #160)

THAT this House urges the Government of Canada to reconsider its cuts to the budget of the Canadian Food Inspection Agency in order to protect Canada's food supply, safeguard animal and plant health, and protect Canadians from preventable health risks by:

- (1) implementing food safety measures,
- (2) managing risks and emergencies regarding food, animals, and plants,
- (3) promoting food safety systems,
- (4) verifying industry compliance with legislation,
- (5) developing inspection programs,
- (6) conducting disease surveillance and laboratory testing and analysis; and
- (7) policing nutrition claims on food labels.
