GOVERNMENT MOTIONS

1. Hon. Mr. Dixon (Motion #119)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to develop and implement a Yukon Water Strategy that will help provide long-term direction for economically and environmentally responsible development, management, and use of water in Yukon and establish principles to guide future decision making.

2. Hon. Mr. Cathers (Motion #211)

THAT this House urges the Yukon Government to continue to:

- (1) respect the fact that there are many hundreds of families in Yukon that depend upon mineral exploration in order to make their mortgage payments, feed themselves, and ensure a proper education and a bright future for their children; and
- (2) support responsible mineral exploration and responsible mining as key elements of a strong, diversified Yukon economy.

3. Hon. Mr. Dixon (Motion #212)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to continue to work with industry, First Nations, and non-governmental organizations to:

- (1) attract investment to Yukon; and
- (2) encourage the development of responsible economic projects.

4. Hon. Mr. Kent (Motion #213)

That this House urges the Government of Yukon to work with Yukon College, the Yukon Mine Training Association, and the mining and exploration industries to train and develop a skilled

work force made up of Yukon residents to meet the current and future needs of the mining and resource sectors.

- 5. Hon. Mr. Cathers (Motion #215)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to continue to work with the Yukon Water Board and the Yukon Environmental and Socio-economic Assessment Board to improve Yukon’s assessment and regulatory processes.

- 6. Hon. Mr. Pasloski (Motion #216)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to preserve and maintain the Free Entry System of mineral allocation in Yukon.

- 7. Hon. Mr. Nixon (Motion #219)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to continue to work with Public Safety Canada and the Royal Canadian Mounted Police to:

- (1) implement the new twenty-year agreement with the Government of Canada for the provision of police services,
(2) support the RCMP in the provision of a professional, effective and efficient territorial police service that is responsive to the needs of all Yukon communities,
(3) address street crime; and
(4) implement the recommendations of the Sharing Common Ground report.

- 8. Hon. Mr. Dixon (Motion #241)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to implement the 2012 Aishihik Bison Herd Management Plan, which includes allowing a Fall hunt in selected areas, reducing the cost of the seal from fifty dollars to ten dollars, and maintaining hunting as the primary management tool.

- 9. Hon. Mr. Kent (Motion #242)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to implement initiatives that will enhance the safety of oil-fired appliances, including regulatory and/or legislative changes, public awareness and training initiatives for industry, based on the report of the Oil-Fired Appliance Working Group and input received from Yukon citizens, municipal and First Nation governments, industry and other interested groups during the community tour that took place in September and early October 2012.

NOTICE PAPER

MOTIONS OTHER THAN GOVERNMENT MOTIONS

1. Mr. Hassard (Motion #367)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to work with the Government of British Columbia to establish a reciprocal fishing license agreement for Atlin Lake.

2. Ms. Hanson (Motion #368)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to increase legislative oversight of capital project spending with the goal of ensuring such projects are:

- (1) undertaken only when there is evidence they will serve demonstrated needs in the most appropriate and cost-effective way,
- (2) planned to anticipate and manage risks,
- (3) delivered on-time and on-budget,
- (4) developed with greater public transparency and accountability; and
- (5) managed in ways that reflect the best practices outlined in numerous reports prepared for the Government of Yukon by its Internal Auditor and by the Office of the Auditor General of Canada.

3. Ms. White (Motion #369)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to immediately:

- (1) implement all of the recommendations of the Select Committee on the Safe Operation and Use of Off-road Vehicles, and
- (2) develop and implement a plan, in conjunction with user groups, to protect environmentally sensitive areas from off-road vehicle use while allowing responsible access to the backcountry.

4. Ms. Stick (Motion #370)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to immediately work with Yukon doctors to ensure the ongoing operation of the Yukon Medical Council so it may continue regulating the practice of medicine and medical care provided by licensed physicians in Yukon.

5. Mr. Silver (Motion #371)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to invite officials from the Yukon Hospital Corporation to appear as witnesses in Committee of the Whole during the 2013 Spring Sitting, to answer questions related to:

- (1) the delayed and over budget Dawson City Hospital,
- (2) the delayed and over budget Watson Lake Hospital; and
- (3) plans to expand the emergency room at Whitehorse General Hospital.

6. Mr. Silver (Motion #372)

THAT this House urges the Government of Yukon to invite officials from the Yukon Development Corporation to appear as witnesses in Committee of the Whole during the 2013 Spring Sitting, to answer questions related to the pending energy shortfall facing Yukon.

7. Mr. Silver (Motion #373)

THAT this House urges the Minister of Energy, Mines and Resources to provide a breakdown of submissions received from Yukoners regarding the Peel Land Use Plan, indicating what plan they supported.
